RE: RE-RECOGNITION OF INSTITUTE FOR PROFESSIONAL AND EXECUTIVE DEVELOPMENT (IPED), UK QUALIFICATIONS IN GHANA

Your application for re-recognition of **Institute for Professional and Executive Development (IPED), UK** qualifications in Ghana refers.

The National Accreditation Board grants approval for the recognition of **IPED-UK** qualifications in Ghana for **four years** with effect from **1st February, 2016**.

Following the assessment of the programmes listed below, the levels of the IPED – UK qualifications and their comparable levels in the Ghanaian educational system are as indicated in Table 1.

Programmes assessed

2. Business Administration and Strategic Management
3. Banking and Finance
4. Marketing Management
5. Human Resource Management

The NAB's recognition of IPED – UK qualifications is based on the underlisted conditions:

1. The programmes assessed and the qualification levels approved would be the only ones recognized by NAB.
2. Unless candidates undertake their courses online; IPED-UK programmes should be run by NAB accredited training providers only.
3. The list of training providers running IPED-UK programmes in Ghana should be forwarded to the Board to facilitate monitoring.
4. The Board should be informed of any changes in the syllabus or on the certificate (template design, etc.) if any occurs within the validity period.
5. The letter detailing the equivalences should not be handed over to the training providers running the programmes and the students.
6. IPED should provide NAB with the details of its local representative/office who co-ordinates the activities of its affiliate centres in Ghana.
7. The comprehensive records of students should be made available at the local office of IPED to facilitate NAB's auditing processes.
8. IPED should take steps to ensure continued integrity in the conduct of its examinations.
